

MINUTES OF THE EXTRA ORDINARY GENERAL BODY MEETING OF GYMNASTICS FEDERATION OF INDIA (GFI) HELD ON SUNDAY, 21-11-2021 STARTING 06:00 PM AT AMAR SINGH CLUB, JAMMU

Sh. Sudhir Mital, President, GFI assumed the chair and welcomed and thanked the members present for making it convenient to attend the Extra Ordinary General Body meeting called under Rule 15 of the GFI Constitution.

Roll call was conducted while reconfirming the names of representatives attending the meeting along with their State/Unit. The list of attendance is as per annexure 1.

After the attendance, the General Secretary Dr Shanti Kumar raised an objection on validity of the meeting on ground of insufficient notice period. The President read and clarified the provisions of the constitution about the timelines and the validity of the meeting and that sufficient notice period is complied with. The President also clarified that the original notice of the meeting was issued by the General Secretary and hence he cannot disown his own notice. The house unanimously rejected the contention of the General Secretary and resolved the notices for the meeting to be valid notices and requested the President to proceed with the agenda.

The President declared the house in order and proceeded to discuss and decide on the Agenda of the meeting.

1. Confirmation of proceedings of the last General Body Meeting

The last general body meeting was held on 21-02-2021 via Video Conferencing. The minutes of the said meeting as circulated among all members by email on November 20, 2021 and tabled before the house were taken as read. No comments were received, and the minutes were accordingly taken as confirmed.

2. Review the status of financials and reconciliation of previous accounts

Shri Kaushik Bidiwala, Treasurer apprised the house about the efforts being undertaken to reconcile and prepare the pending financials of GFI since 2010.

As per discussion in the last General Body meeting, the services of Mr Dilip Sarvaiya and his office are being availed to complete the task of regularizing the past accounts of GFI.

Most of the transactions during 2011-2019 have been traced and accounted for except certain transactions during the 2011-15 term when Sh Shantikumar was the Treasurer. It was already brought to notice of the members during the last general body meeting that Sh Shantikumar has not provided any financial records and information concerning his tenure as Treasurer of GFI during 2011-15 and the status remains the same since the last general body meeting.

The matter was discussed, and it was decided to form a committee comprising of Dr C Prabhakar, Vice President – GFI, Mr Kaushik Bidiwala, Treasurer – GFI and General Secretary – GFI to complete the pending task of financials and audit. The committee may co-opt additional members and was authorized to travel, make visits, call for records and take all other steps that may be necessary to complete the task in an expedited manner so as to complete within 3 months.

The matter of pending payment to the Organizers towards participation of Indian delegation for the Artistic Gymnastics World Championships in Japan was also brought up and it was decided that GFI should make the pending payment.

3. Discussions / Decisions on State Gymnastics Association including affiliations and status of Dispute Committee report / proceedings

Maharashtra

The President informed that the matter of dispute in Maharashtra Gymnastics Association has been settled by the report of the Dispute Committee under the Chairmanship of Sh Digvijay Singh (copy already sent to all units) wherein the Committee, after considering all information and facts and after giving reasonable opportunity to both factions, was of unanimous opinion that the faction headed by Sh Sanjay Shete as President and Sh Makarand Joshi as General Secretary of Maharashtra Amateur Gymnastics Association should be considered as the official member unit of GFI.

The Dispute Committee was formed by the GFI which as such is bound by the findings of the said Committee and hence the findings were accepted by the President in letter and spirit and circulated to members for information. The resolution of the long pending dispute of Maharashtra Amateur Gymnastics by the Dispute Committee in favour of faction lead by Sh Sanjay Shete as President and Sh Makarand Joshi as General Secretary had been overwhelmingly appreciated and welcomed by Member Units of GFI. The house ratified the acceptance of the Dispute Committee report in the matter of Maharashtra. Further the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in W.P.(C).No.7489/2021 dated 18/11/2021 is also upholding the authority of the GFI, the same has been taken into account.

The following resolutions were passed:

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the faction headed by Shri Sanjay Shete as President and Shri Makarand Joshi as General Secretary of Maharashtra Amateur Gymnastics Association be and is hereby considered as the official member unit of GFI.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the President, GFI be and is hereby authorized to issue an appropriate confirmation / affiliation letter in favour of Maharashtra Amateur Gymnastics Association headed by Shri Sanjay Shete as President and Shri Makarand Joshi as General Secretary.

Telangana

The President provided a background on the matter of multiple factions/associations in Telangana and on the matter of elections of Telangana Gymnastics Association which could not have been recognized or accepted by GFI.

Mr Ashok Sahoo who was appointed as Observer from GFI submitted in his report that he was not extended any cooperation and no documents concerning the elections were shared with him. Also, many district associations had also met him to register their complaints regarding serious irregularities in the election process.

To resolve this situation concerning Gymnastics in the state of Telangana in an expedited manner and in the interest of the Gymnasts in the state, the President – GFI, under the provisions of GFI Constitution vide proceedings dated 3rd October 2021, constituting an Ad-hoc Committee to conduct fresh elections and in the meantime to manage the Sport of Gymnastic in the State of Telangana. However, the said proceedings were stayed by the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana vide order dated 28/10/2021.

Although there has been an order by the Telangana High Court, the matter concerns only on the formation of Ad-hoc Committee. The situation concerning recognition of Telangana Gymnastics Association remains to be resolved.

After discussions, the following decisions were resolved by the house,

RESOLVED THAT the report of the GFI appointed Observer Shri Ashok Sahoo be and is hereby accepted with ratification of non-recognition of the elections of Telangana Gymnastics Association.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the matter of Telangana Gymnastics Association be and is hereby referred to the Disciplinary Committee to whom the relevant information and documents be sent by President, GFI.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT in order to protect the interest of the Gymnasts, coaches and other relevant stakeholders of Telangana, they will be allowed to participate in GFI recognized events under the name and banner of GFI till the time the matter of the Gymnastics Association in Telangana is resolved as per the established procedures and in the meantime the President or any person so authorized by the President may take such steps as may be necessary for this purpose.

Tamilnadu

The President informed that the elections of Tamilnadu Gymnastics Association was held by the Election Officer Mr. L. Chandrakumar (court appointed RO) in compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble Madras High Court dated 04/11/2020 in C. S. No. 239/2020 and O. A. No. 438/2020 and A. No. 2117/2020, and he has communicated the results vide his proceedings dated 02/11/2021.

Gymnastics Federation of India (GFI) is party to the above orders/judgment and is bound by the same. The results as published by the Returning Officer were accordingly accepted and a confirmation to that effect was issued to the newly elected office bearers of Tamilnadu Gymnastics Association which are as follows:

The change in the recognition of the office bearers of Tamilnadu Gymnastics Association was taken on record. The house congratulated the new office bearers and hope that they would work towards the upliftment of Gymnastics in Tamilnadu and contribute to the objectives of the Federation.

Haryana

The President informed that the report of the Dispute Committee headed by Sh.Digvijay Singh has been received by GFI, wherein the committee gave its findings and recommended that the faction lead by Sh. Suraj Pal Amu as President and Sh. Balbir Singh as General Secretary is the bonafide body working in the interest of Sport of Gymnastics in the State of Haryana.

The president further informed that the report of the Dispute Committee in favour Haryana Gymnastics Association headed by Sh. Suraj Pal Amu as President and Sh. Balbir Singh as General Secretary has to be accepted. The General Assembly unanimously accepted the same.

The following resolutions were passed accordingly

RESOLVED THAT the faction headed by Sh. Suraj Pal Amu as President and Sh. Balbir Singh as General Secretary of Haryana Gymnastics Association be and is hereby considered as the official member unit of GFI.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the President, GFI be and is hereby authorized to issue an appropriate confirmation / affiliation letter in favour of Haryana Gymnastics Association headed by Shri Suraj Pal Amu as President and Shri Balbir Singh as General Secretary.

Chhattisgarh

The house requested the Dispute Committee to submits its report on the dispute with regard to the State of Chhattisgarh, and further authorised the President to take final decision on the report of the Dispute Committee regarding the State of Chhattisgarh.

Misc. Matters

In the matter of State Gymnastics Association, the President informed that it was brought to his notice that Election of office bearers in certain State Associations have become long overdue which is in violation of their own Constitution and also contrary

to GFI Constitution. He emphasized the importance for the member units to be compliant as per their respective Constitution as a matter of good governance and fair practice.

It was discussed that all the member units shall provide to GFI a status report about their last elections and about when the next elections are due. Wherever elections are overdue, the same should be conducted by the concerned member unit within 4 months.

The President – GFI was authorized to seek any further information from the member units and take appropriate actions against non-compliant / non-cooperative member units in line with the Constitution of GFI.

4. Review and finalization of National Event Calendar (Conduct of National Championships and other national events) for 2021-22 and 2022-23

The President explained that the Covid-19 situation is easing across the country and sporting events are gradually returning to normal. It was desired that the Nationals across all age groups and disciplines be conducted for the year 2021-22 and 2022-23 and accordingly proposals were sought from member units.

The proposals for hosting National Championships were received and approved as detailed below:

RESOLVED THAT the allotment of Championships to the respective States shall be subject to the condition that they should have conducted their election within the time frame as per their Constitution.

5. Filling of vacancy of Vice President

The President has informed that, Mr Digvijay Singh had resigned from his position of Vice President of GFI thereby the position of 1 Vice President have become vacant.

The House resolved to refer this issue to the Executive Committee as per the GFI Constitution.

6. Review of election of General Secretary under GFI Constitution and decision on this matter

As the house is aware, the Government of India through Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has vide its letter dated 6/7/2020 addressed to the President, GFI informed that since Sh Shanti Kumar had served 2 (two) consecutive terms in GFI, he could not have been permitted to serve 3rd consecutive term as per the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 and accordingly, GFI was asked to advise Sh Shantikumar to demit office of the Secretary General and hold fresh election before seeking recognition of the Sports Ministry. Sh Shanti Kumar had preferred a Writ Petition in the Hon'ble High Court of Manipur against the said letter wherein the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 16/07/2020 had suspended the operation of the letter dated 06/07/2020 by the Under Secretary to the Government of India.

The matter is currently sub judice with Hon'ble High Court of Manipur. It was clarified that the matter before the Hon'ble High Court of Manipur concerns the election of Sh Shantikumar with respect to the National Sports Development Code while the current agenda is about reviewing the election of Sh Shantikumar under the Constitution of GFI.

This agenda does not violate in any manner the Order dated 16/07/2020 of the Hon'ble High Court of Manipur. However, with great respect to the judicial proceedings and as a matter of abundant caution, this item in the agenda number 6 specific to Tenure and Terms of Office Bearers (Article - 11(2) of GFI Constitution) the Election of General Secretary was not taken up for discussion.

The President was authorized to review the matter for the purpose of taking it up in GFI's reply to the Hon'ble Manipur High Court.

7. Review of conduct and role of General Secretary in functioning of GFI and decision on this matter

The President explained and reiterated the detailed note that had been circulated by him to the members concerning the conduct and role of General Secretary in functioning of GFI. There were innumerable instances of indiscipline and total non-cooperation by Sh. Shanti Kumar which is seriously affecting the smooth running of the affairs of the GFI. He elaborated in some length on Sh. Shantikumar's selective

issue of affiliations to States, non-verification of gymnast's participation certificate on baseless ground, which was seriously affected their carrier and job prospects, refusal to issue notice for meetings, issue of legal notice to the President regarding the operation of bank accounts and other flimsy reasons, appointment of observers, coaches, judges, forwarding his own name to overseas participation without any consultation and approval of the President. Also, he has shown total disinterest and apathy in any matter relating to the development of Gymnastics in India. The President mentioned and explained that how his conduct has been continuing in spite of repeated counselling/advice for nearly two years.

The President also informed the house about the various litigations filed very recently in the last week by Dr Shanti Kumar in the Hon'ble High Court of Manipur regarding the Agenda items 6 & 7 which he himself had been circulating by WhatsApp to Members.

The house by overwhelming majority expressed serious concerns on such mis conduct on the part of the General Secretary and felt the same is highly reprehensible and detrimental to the Federation.

In the matter of Telangana Gymnastics Association, Sh Shantikumar had gone over and above his authority to appoint an observer for their elections and in issuance of an affiliation letter in favour of Telangana Gymnastics Association on the basis of a purported election in complete disregard of the observations of the GFI appointed observer and without even waiting for the Final report from the GFI Observer.

A notice calling for explanation on this matter was issued to Sh Shanti Kumar on 8th November 2021 to which Sh Shantikumar gave an incomplete response. Hence, the matter was referred to the GFI Disciplinary Committee to be dealt with as per the Constitution of GFI along with the relevant documents.

The Disciplinary Committee framed charges on the matter and served notice dated 16th November 2021 on Sh Shantikumar seeking explanation on the said charges. Sh Shantikumar had responded with his explanation vide his letter dated 18th November 2021.

The president informed the house, that on consideration of the relevant documents on record, the Disciplinary Committee has submitted an interim recommendation and the operative portion of the recommendation are as follows,

“Now, after considering the explanation submitted, the committee is of the view that a detailed enquiry is required to be conducted.

Hence in the interest of Justice and fair play, it is recommended that Mr. Shanti Kumar Singh may be placed under suspension as per Article 29 Notes 3, pending the Disciplinary proceedings so as to avoid tampering of evidence and witnesses”

The President placed the above report before the House for Consideration.

The house with overwhelming majority agreed to the recommendation of the Disciplinary Committee and demanded the immediate suspension of Sh. Shantikumar. At this juncture, the President, considerate on the continuity and smooth functioning of the Federation and its activities, proposed that, rather than placing him under suspension it would be appropriate in the interest of Sports, to restrain him from issuing any communication relating to affairs of GFI except with prior specific instructions/approval from the President or any other person authorized by the President for this purpose. Such arrangement may be put in place till the completion of the Disciplinary proceedings. He further suggested that the Disciplinary Committee should try to conclude the disciplinary proceedings within a period of two months. After a detailed discussion the General Council unanimously appreciated, welcomed and accepted the suggestion made by the President.

The following resolutions were pass accordingly

- RESOLVED THAT Mr Shantikumar be and is hereby restrained from issuing any communication relating to affairs of GFI except with prior specific instructions/approval from the President or any other person authorized by the President for this purpose. Such arrangement will be effective till the Disciplinary proceedings against Mr Shantikumar are concluded.
- RESOLVED FURTHER THAT Mr Shantikumar shall surrender the official Email ID and password to the President with immediate effect. In default the President is hereby authorised by the General Council either to create a new official Email Id or to change existing password, and the President, GFI is authorized to inform various authorities and other stakeholders including but not limited to the FIG, IOA, MYAS, SAI, etc. to update their records with the new email address of GFI.
- RESOLVED FURTHER THAT if required, the President himself or he may authorize a member of the General Council to perform such function and duties of General Secretary which are necessary for the proper functioning of GFI.
- RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the President, GFI be and is hereby authorized to communicate the decisions under these resolutions to concerned authorities including by not limited to FIG and IOA.

8. Authorizations and procedures for smooth functioning of the Federation

GFI Representatives at IOA AGM

The President informed that the Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) will be held on 19 December 2021 at Srimanta Sankardeva International Auditorium, Guwahati wherein the Elections is one of the items on Agenda. GFI being a member of IOA, is entitled to be represented at the IOA AGM with up to 3 representatives, the nomination for which needs to be sent to IOA by 30th November 2021.

The matter was discussed, and it was proposed to approve and nominate the following members of the GFI General Council as representatives of GFI for the IOA AGM currently scheduled at Guwahati on 19th December 2021

1. Dr C Prabhakar Sr. Vice President of GFI
2. Mr Kaushik Bidiwala Treasurer of GFI
3. Mr Manoj Kumar Joint Secretary

The following resolutions were passed:

RESOLVED THAT Mr C Prabhakar, Mr Kaushik Bidiwala and Mr Manoj Kumar be and hereby are approved and nominated as representatives of Gymnastics Federation of India for the Annual General Body Meeting of the Indian Olympic Association currently scheduled at Guwahati on 19th December 2021.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the President, GFI be and is hereby authorized to forward the names approved as representatives of GFI to the Indian Olympic Association.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the names approved shall continue to remain valid for the said Annual General Body Meeting of Indian Olympic Association even if the same is rescheduled or adjourned.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the President, GFI be and is hereby authorized to substitute the name of any of the person herein approved and nominated as representatives of GFI with another person being a member of General Council of GFI. The person so nominated to substitute will be treated as originally approved and nominated by the General Council of GFI. Such substitution be preferred in the case where one or more of the nominated person(s) is/are unable to attend the Annual General Meeting of IOA for any unforeseen circumstances.

General Authorizations

For the smooth and efficient functioning of the Federation, it is imperative that the powers and duties be expressly delegated. Moreover, the actions taken so far are required to be ratified for the purpose of sanctity and authorizations needs to be provided to deal with the litigations in various jurisdictions concerning Gymnastics Federation of India. Accordingly, the following resolutions were passed

RESOLVED THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President be and is hereby authorized to take and implement necessary decisions and actions in terms of Clause 14(ii) (a), (b), (c), (d), (f), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m) and (n) of the Rules and Regulations of GFI as permitted by Clause 14(ii)(n).

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the past decisions/actions, if any, taken by Mr Sudhir Mital, President in accordance with the aforesaid resolution be and are hereby ratified.

General Authorization for Legal/Judicial Matters

"RESOLVED THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized to appear on behalf of the Federation, to sign, verify and submit applications, petitions, complaints, written statements, counterclaims, objection petition, complaints, memorandum of appeal and any other documents as

may be required to be submitted to the court or any other authority or organization/individual in connection with any court case or legal proceedings in various courts and / or such other lawsuits wherein the Federation is a defendant or a plaintiff or otherwise involved in any other ways."

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized to engage counsels, to execute power of attorney in favour of any person in relation to any court case, to swear Affidavits on behalf of the Federation and to do all such acts, deeds and things in this regard."

Specific Authorization to deal with matter at High Court of Manipur

"RESOLVED THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized to appear on behalf of the Federation, to sign, verify and submit applications, petitions, complaints, written statements, counterclaims, objection petition, memorandums of appeal and any other documents as may be required to be submitted on behalf of the Federation to the court or any other authority or organization/individual in the matter of W.P. (C) No. 385 of 2020 before the High Court of Manipur and connected matters"

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized to engage counsels, to execute power of attorney in favour of any person, to swear Affidavits on behalf of the Federation and to do all such acts, deeds and things in this regard in relation to the matter of W.P. (C) No. 385 of 2020 before the High Court of Manipur and connected matters."

Specific Authorization to deal with matter at High Court of Telangana

"RESOLVED THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized to appear on behalf of the Federation, to sign, verify and submit applications, petitions, complaints, written statements, counterclaims, objection petition, memorandums of appeal and any other documents as may be required to be submitted on behalf of the Federation to the court or any other authority or organization/individual in the matter of W.P. (C) No. 26930 of 2021 before the High Court for the State of Telangana and connected matters"

"RESOLVED FURTHER THAT Mr Sudhir Mital, President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized to engage counsels, to execute power of attorney in favour of any person, to swear Affidavits on behalf of the Federation and to do all such acts, deeds and things in this regard in relation to the matter of W.P. (C) No. 26930 of 2021 before the High Court for the State of Telangana and connected matters."

General Authorization as Authorized Signatory

RESOLVED THAT the Mr Sudhir Mital President and Mr C Prabhakar, Vice President be and are hereby severally authorized as the authorized signatories of the Gymnastics Federation of India for the purpose of providing and/or executing any undertaking,

declaration or bond on behalf of the Gymnastics Federation of India and all other matters incidental thereto.

Procedures

- As per Art.12 (a)(1) and Art.12(c) (1) of the GFI Constitution nomenclature of GFI President and General Secretary shall be incorporated in the official letterhead of GFI to the effect that The President (Chief Executive) and General Secretary (Executive Officer) and the same is approved. The same was adopted for use as the official letterhead of GFI.
- It was discussed that the Email of GFI shall be shared between the three principal Office Bearers i.e. the President, General Secretary and the Treasurer so that all three remain informed of the affairs of GFI and all national and International Events and the Treasurer is always in picture of the Financial implications.
- Accordingly, the official email ID of GFI (i.e. indiagymnastics2019@gmail.com or the new email if so created) will be operated by the GFI President, General Secretary, Treasurer and any other person authorized by President, GFI for that purpose.
- Such email will be in addition to the official email address of President, GFI i.e. presidentgfi19@gmail.com

All mails from and to GFI should be routed through the official email address of GFI and/or official email address of President GFI. No personal email will be used for any official GFI business. Further all the State Units shall hereafter use only exclusive Official Email IDs, sending and receiving mails through private mail IDs shall be avoided.

- It was also decided that the correspondence/Postal address of GFI shall be that of GFI Office at New Delhi and till such time the office of GFI is set up, it shall be the address of President GFI at New Delhi
- All events involving financial assistance would need to be discussed with the Treasurer and cleared by the President

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
