Judges:

Each participating State must send 15th Cycle qualified judges as per the following requirements:

- If participating with Team – 2 Judges in each of the discipline
- If participating with Individual Gymnasts – 1 Judge in each of the discipline

Technical Rules:

The competition shall be conducted as per the FIG Code of Points + Rules & Regulations (2022 - 2024). The competition director will have the power to clarify or provide for any doubts or difficulty.

Registration:

All states/affiliated units shall be required to submit their Team/Gymnasts entry by filling up the Entry Form enclosed herewith and email the same to gakblr.2014@gmail.com & indiagymnastics2019@gmail.com latest by 10th December 2022.

In addition, the Entry form in original, duly signed and sealed and complete in all respect including date of birth and father's name should be submitted during registration on 15th December 2022. Incomplete and/or unsigned forms will be rejected. *No gymnast / team shall be allowed to participate without the aforesaid Entry Form.*

Age Certificate:

All the gymnasts participating in the championship shall be required to produce duly completed and authorized Age Certificate / Aadahar Card (Photocopy verified by respective associations) irrespective of whether their registration was made with GFI any previous occasion. No gymnasts shall be allowed to participate without proper age certificate.

In case any gymnast is found guilty of producing incorrect or forged age certificate, his/her eligibility to participate in any type of championships may be ceased.

Entry/Affiliation Fees:

Entry fee of Rs. 1000/- (lump sum for Sub-Junior, Junior and Senior, if not paid) and affiliation fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. 2000 in case of Railways and SSCB, if not paid) for the year 2022 - 2023 should be deposited with the Treasurer of GFI before the start of the competition. Non-payment of fee may result into the respective team being barred from participation.

Registration Fee:

Each participating member including officials (except Technical Officials) shall have to pay Rs.500/- (Per Head/Per Event) towards registration fee.

Protest:

Protest, if any, should be lodged with the Competition Director with a fee of Rs. 500/- as per the FIG Rules. The Protest must be submitted on the letter head of the respective state/unit and should be signed by an authorized signatory.

Reception:

The host state will provide all the facilities to the participants including transport from / to the Bengaluru Railway Station / Airport / Bus Station and will provide accommodation only to the nominated Players & officials from their respective Associations.

Guideline of Selection for KIYG 2022:

Gymnast will be selected as per ranking and selection criteria of 5th Khelo India Youth Games from Junior & Senior National Championship 2022 - 23.
